Gentlemen:


I am an incumbent Republican candidate for Bergen County Freeholder, having been elected for a one year unexpired term last November. My affidavit is being filed separately regarding the fact that expenses for my candidacy did not exceed \$1,000.00.

A group of friends, last year, in September and October, raised some money for me by way of selling \$15.00 and \$30.00 tickets to a picnic and a dinner. The proceeds of these affairs were put into account #086-0674-9 at Citizens First National Bank, Saddle River, New Jersey, 07458 under the name of "Citizens for Ken Sherwood".

The balance in the account on April 24, 1973 was \$237.88. Expenditures since were \$16.00 for two tickets for a luncheon of the Bergen County Women's Republican Club on May 2 and bank service charges resulting in a balance today of \$220.88. There have been no receipts during the reporting period.

How should this item be reported, if at all, or should it be shown as an opening balance for the general election campaign?
