Dear Mr. Cunningham:

Your letter dated March 24, 1976 to the New Jersey
Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"),
including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded
to me for reply.

In the opinion of the Commission, you need not comply
with the 50 cent per voter limitation for your upcoming
municipal election. The expenditure limitations contained
in the Act are no longer in effect. We are enclosing a copy
of the letter from the Commission to the appropriate election
officials dated March 30, 1976 dealing in part with this
question.
