> The New Jersey Campaign Contributions and Expenditure Reporting Act, Chapter 83, Laws of 1973, as Amended and Supplemented ("the Act") Your Letter Dated August 5, 1976 Opinion #(0-28-76)

Dear Mr. Buehrer:

Your letter dated August 5, 1976 to the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"), including a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to me for reply.

We are not entirely clear on the question raised by your letter of August 5th. To the extent that the activities referr to in the obtaining of ads and printing a journal represent organization expenses for the Committee, there is no requiremen that those expenditures be treated as expenditures in aid of any candidates for the general election, assuming that the facts support such a determination, and the fact that the payment is made after the date of the primary would not be regarded by the Commission as being determinative of the question.

Contributions and expenditures with respect to the ongoing operations of a political party committee, if unrelated to election activity, do not become contributions or expenditur with respect to the candidacy of a candidate solely by virtue of their having been received or made after the date of the primary.

If however, the intended or actual use of the journal. is to aid a candidacy of one or more candidates, or the proceeds realized from the journal are used for the aid of a candidacy of one or more candidates, then these expenditures in preparing and presenting the journal and the proceeds, would be required to be included in election reports.
