Dear Mr. Coldren:

Your letter dated May 18, 1977 to the New Jersey Election
Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"), including a
request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to me for
reply.

Your letter suggests that the organization which in fact
ordered and paid for the primary election flyers is "The 1977
Campaign Committee, Cape May County". In those circumstances,
the expenditures should be reflected in the reports of The
1977 Campaign Committee, Cape May County, with such notations
as you may deem necessary to clarify the situation respecting
the incorrect attribution.

In the absence of formal complaint, the Commission
would not anticipate taking any further action. In the
event of a formal complaint, the letter of clarification
would be made a part of any subsequent proceeding.
