Dear Mr. Mantell:

Your letter dated March 26, 1980, to the New Jersey
Election Law Enforcement Commission ("the Commission"), in-
cluding a request for advisory opinion, has been forwarded to
me for reply.

The Act is applicable to elections for public office in
the State of New Jersey or any political subdivision thereof,
but is not applicable to elections for federal office. Ac-
cordingly, the answer to the questions posed by your question-
naire is that there are no reporting requirements applicable with
respect to solicitations for use in connection with elections
for federal office (Paragraph No. 2 in your questionnaire).

In view of the answer to that question, there are no re-
porting requirements under the Act applicable to the remaining
questions which you pose.
