There are three Statewide Ballot Questions on the 1999 General Election Ballot:

Public Question No. 1 - Statewide Transportation and Local Bridge Bond Act of 1999;

Public Question No. 2 - Constitutional Amendment to Increase the Property Tax Deduction for Veterans; and,

Public Question No. 3 - Constitutional Amendment to Provide that State Lottery Net Proceeds Will Not Be Used To Fund Prison Programs.

In support of Public Question No. 1, a political committee called "Save Our Bridges Coalition, Inc." filed a 29-day preelection report (\$5,000 was raised and \$0 was spent.)

SPECIAL SENATE RACE - 29TH DISTRICT

There is a Special Senate race in District 29: Sharpe James (D) raised \$1,800 and spent \$0 as of the 29-day preelection report.
