

MINUTES OF COMMISSION MEETING

November 29, 1973

1. Marlboro Complaint - The Hearing Examiner's report was considered, no exceptions having been filed, and the Commission by a vote of 3-0 approved the Hearing Examiner's report. The Hearing Examiner, the Honorable Sidney Goldman, was not present during deliberations and took no part in the deliberations by the Commission.
2. Schluter vs Martindell - The Commission considered the Hearing Examiner's report filed by the Honorable Bartholomew Sheehan, the transcript of the hearing and the exceptions filed by counsel for both parties. The Hearing Examiner was not present and took no part in the deliberations of the Commission.

By a vote of 3-0, the Commission approved the report of the Hearing Examiner relative to the Keys-Martin obligation.

By a vote of 3-0, the Commission approved the Hearing Examiner's report relative to the Byrne contribution.

By a vote of 3-0, the Commission approved the Hearing Examiner's report relative to the expenditure made to Mr. Arcioni.

3. Herbert H. Shaw, Candidate for the Assembly, District 32 - The Commission ordered Mr. Shaw to file affidavits for each reporting period immediately.
4. Oris A. Thompson, Assembly 18 - The Commission ordered Mr. Thompson to file all necessary reports immediately.
5. H. Joseph Deitz, Senate 11 - The Commission ordered a hearing and investigation into the expenditures listed in Mr. Deitz's reports as payments to R. M. Howard. The Commission also ordered that that investigation and subsequent hearing examined further into the circumstances surrounding the failure to file an October 30 report until November 28, 1973.
6. The Commission adopted the following resolution:  
BE IT RESOLVED, that the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission hereby extends thanks to the County Clerks of each of the 21 counties of the State of New Jersey for their efforts on behalf of the Commission, on behalf of candidates for public office in the 1973 general election, and on behalf of the people of New Jersey in undertaking to assist the Commission and candidates alike in facilitating the delivery of returns, the distribution of forms and the providing of information to candidates.
7. Commissioner Goldman will consult Ernst & Ernst relative to their availability and interest for complete review of the Byrne and Sandman filings.
8. The Commission adopted a motion to re-draft FORM R-1, the affidavit form and the instructions for utilization in the school board elections to be held on February 5 and February 13, 1974. It was determined that the affidavit might be utilized in a single filing, rather than on three separate dates as was done in the general election.
