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1983 GENERAL ELECTION ADVISORY #15

Attached is a Summary Report reflecting cash balances of surplus campaign funds by legislative candidates and their supporting committees participating in the 1983 general election. As of 15 days after the election, candidates and committees reported \$1,002,919 remaining in their campaign accounts. Outstanding obligations, including loans to the campaign and obligations to vendors, equals \$273,971 as of the close of the reporting period.

The candidates' and committees' Gross Funds Available (column 1) represents the closing balance on hand in the campaign depository as reflected on Page 2, the Statement of Campaign Depository and Treasury, of the 15 day post election reports. The Outstanding Obligations (column 2) reflects the total unpaid campaign obligations reported on Schedule E, Outstanding Obligations, of this report. The Net Funds Available (column 3) was calculated by subtracting the reported outstanding obligations from the reported closing balance. In cases where the outstanding obligations exceed the remaining funds available, the Net Funds Available has been reported in this advisory as zero.

Ten candidates and committees who filed a final report reflected the transfer of remaining funds to other committees not participating in the 1983 general election. The total amount of such transfers equal \$64,579. This figure has not been included in the amount of Net Funds Available. (See Table II).

The information contained in this summary reflects information reported on the 15 day post election reports which were filed on behalf of candidates and committees participating in the 1983 legislative election and received by the Commission as of December 1, 1983. These reports contain financial information of the campaign through November 22, 1983. Those candidates and committees whose 15 day post election report is not final must file a periodic report every 60 days, the first report being due on January 23, 1983.
