Frederick M. Herrmann, the Executive Director of the Election Law Enforcement Commission announced today that the Commission at its public meeting Tuesday, April 16, 1985, certified \$83,770.00 in public matching funds to gubernatorial primary election candidates as follows:

To date, the Commission has certified a total of \$301,319.98 in public matching funds to Newark Mayor Gibson (D) and \$314,860.00 in public matching funds to former State Senator Wiley (D). Including yesterday's certification, the Commission has certified a total of \$1,240,180.36 as follows:

The Commission has transmitted the certifications to the State Treasurer who, it is anticipated, will issue checks later this week. The checks will be deposited by the Commission in the candidates' public funds bank accounts and will be available for use immediately thereafter.

On Monday, the Commission received applications for public matching funds from four candidates. The Commission received additional applications for the current submission period from former U. S. Attorney Robert J. Del Tufo, Mayor Gibson, State Senator John F. Russo, and Mr. Wiley. The candidates reported contributions (less refunds) for this submission period as follows:

Monday marked the ninth date on which candidates could make application for public matching funds. To date a combined total of \$1,074,944.21 in contributions raised (less refunds) has been indicated by candidates making application for public matching funds.

The New Jersey public financing program provides that each dollar of a contribution be matched with two dollars of public funds after a candidate has raised and spent a minimum of \$50,000.00 in contributions of \$800.00 or less. Thus, if all contributions submitted for match in the ninth submission period

are found to be eligible after Commission review, Mr. Del Tufo will be eligible for \$24,366.04 in public matching funds, Mayor Gibson will be eligible for \$23,900.00 in public matching funds, Senator Russo will be eligible for \$34,750.00 and Mr. Wiley will be eligible to receive \$24,420.00.

The submissions received Monday will be reviewed and the Commission will certify to the State Treasurer an amount each candidate is eligible to receive for the ninth submission period at its meeting on Tuesday, April 23, 1985.
