According to Frederick M. Herrmann, Executive Director of the Election Law Enforcement Commission, Senate and Assembly candidates raised \$7,367,484 and spent \$3,659,050, or 50 percent of their receipts during the period prior to October 5, 1987.

Herrmann said that "44 percent of legislative receipts, or \$2,828,894, was attributed to Assembly candidates while 56 percent, or \$3,505,363, was raised by Senate candidates."

In terms of expenditures, Herrmann said that \$2,029,462, or 57 percent of their receipts was spent by Senate candidates and \$1,520,497, or 43 percent of their receipts was spent by Assembly candidates.

Campaign financial figures reported on candidates' 29-day preelection filings show a decrease in receipts by Assembly candidates of 5 percent over the same period in 1985.

These same reports indicate that there has been a 12 percent decrease in spending by these assembly candidates over two years ago.

Comparisons to the 1985 general election cannot be made for State Senate candidates because there was no Senate contest that year.

"As of 29 days before the election," said Herrmann, "Democrats have outraised and outspent Republicans. Democrats have raised \$4,090,467 compared to the Republicans \$3,277,016. Regarding spending, Democrats have spent \$2,167,668 and Republicans \$1,491,382."

He said that Democratic Assembly candidates received \$1,563,953 for an increase of 15 percent over the same period in 1985 (\$1,356,686). Republican Assembly candidates received \$1,264,940, equaling a decrease from 1985 of 21 percent (\$1,609,366).

Herrmann said that Assembly Democratic expenditures reported on the 29-day report amounted to \$809,506, for a 2 percent increase over the same period in 1985 (\$793,578). Assembly Republican expenditures were listed at \$710,991 for a 24 percent decrease from 1985 (\$931,583).

According to Herrmann: "Democratic Senate receipts totalled \$2,227,034 and expenditures totalled \$1,249,071. Republican Senate candidates reported receipts of \$1,278,328 and expenditures of \$780,390."

Herrmann added that overall incumbents have both outraised and outspent challengers thus far.

Incumbent receipts totalled \$4,574,676 and challenger receipts totalled \$1,889,989. Thus, incumbents raised 142 percent more than challengers did. In terms of expenditures, incumbents reported spending \$2,158,666 or 55 percent more than challengers (\$1,391,292).

In 1987, Assembly incumbents have raised \$1,844,113, or 87 percent over Assembly challengers receipts of \$984,781.

On the 1985 29-day report, Assembly incumbents reported receiving \$1,980,282, or 144 percent more than challengers did during this period. Challenger receipts totalled \$812,565.

Herrmann said that spending by Assembly incumbents amounted to \$881,204 so far in 1987 compared to \$639,292 by challengers. Thus, incumbents spending has been 38 percent more than challengers. In 1985, incumbent Assembly candidates' expenditures amounted to \$1,033,177 compared to \$692,173 for challengers. In 1985, incumbents spent 49 percent more than challengers during this period.

He said that 1987 Senate incumbents have raised \$2,730,563, or 202 percent more than challengers (\$905,208) as reported on the 29-day report. Senate incumbent expenditures totalled \$1,277,462, or 70 percent more than Senate challengers who have spent \$751,999.

The breakdown between Assembly and Senate candidates, between incumbent and challenger candidates and between Republican and Democratic candidates do not equal the figures for total contributions. Some committees supported both Assembly and Senate candidates and it is not possible to attribute the funds raised among the Assembly and Senate candidates they supported. Therefore, funds raised by such committees were not counted in the totals. Similarly, it is not possible to divide funds raised by a political committee supporting both challenger and incumbent candidates between those candidates, so such committees were not tabulated in the incumbent/challenger figures. Finally, funds raised by Independent candidates were not counted in the political party figures.
