Frederick M. Herrmann, Executive Director of the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission, announced today that, as of the 20-day postelection reports, campaign spending for the 1997 general legislative election increased by 40 percent over the amount spent in 1993, the last year when both houses of the Legislature, as well as the Governor, were up for election.

Herrmann stated that "this legislative election is the most expensive in New Jersey history."

"Approximately \$21.3 million was spent in 1997, compared to \$15.2 million in 1993," said Herrmann. "This increase was partially caused by the spending of political party committees at the State and county levels."

As a result of campaign finance law reform in 1993, these 48 committees are able to receive up to \$30,000 per year from contributors; a candidate, on the other hand, can receive only \$1,800 per election from individuals, corporations, and unions and \$5,900 from PACs.

"Political party committees are in a position to raise and spend highly significant amounts of money in legislative races," said Herrmann.

The Commission recommended in its eleventh and twelfth White Papers (analyzing fundraising and spending by Statewide and county political party committees) that the \$30,000 contribution limit for money received by the two State political party committees be reduced to \$15,000 and the \$30,000 limit for the four political party legislative leadership committees and the 42 county political party committees be reduced to \$10,000. Such a change would minimize any appearance of undue influence by these committees in the electoral process.

Spending by Senate candidates increased by 74 percent in 1997, but spending by Assembly candidates increased by only 8 percent. The Senate spent \$12.9 million in 1997 and \$7.4 million in 1993. The Assembly spent \$8.4 million in 1997 and \$7.8 million in 1993.

The total amount raised by legislative candidates increased by 45 percent over 1993 figures (\$26.9 million in 1997 to \$18.6 million in 1993).

“It should also be noted that these figures, which represent the total fundraising by legislative candidates, include funds carried over from the primary election, as well as other past elections,” Herrmann stated.

A candidate is required to report “total receipts,” which include funds raised during the general election cycle, along with funds carried over from prior elections. The total fundraising figures, therefore, represent the total amount of funds available to be spent by the candidates.

The Republicans raised 12 percent more than the Democrats in the general election races for legislative office, but the Democrats spent slightly more. The Republicans raised approximately \$14.2 million and the Democrats raised \$12.7 million; the Republicans spent \$10.5 million and the Democrats spent \$10.8 million. Independents raised only \$13,099 and spent \$12,530; these amounts are substantially down from the 1993 figures (\$198,811 was raised in 1993 and \$193,192 was spent). When 1997 is compared to 1993, fundraising for Independents is down 93 percent and spending is down 94 percent.

Predictably, incumbent candidates raised substantially more than the challengers. In 1997, incumbents raised \$16.8 million or 62 percent of the total amount raised (\$26.9 million). Challengers raised \$10.1 million, or 38 percent of the total amount raised. However, when comparing incumbent/challenger fundraising reported in 1993, incumbents in 1997 raised a smaller percentage of the total funds. In 1993, incumbents raised 68 percent of the total funds raised, compared to the 62 percent raised in 1997. Accordingly, it appears that challengers made advances in their fundraising efforts.

The Senate candidates raised more than the Assembly candidates in 1997, whereas the Senate and Assembly raised about the same in 1993. In 1997, the Senate raised approximately \$15.7 million, and the Assembly raised approximately \$11.2 million. In 1993, both houses raised approximately \$9.3 million each.

There was one Statewide Ballot Question Committee which filed reports for the general election. The "Clean Water Coalition, Inc.," reportedly raised \$65,300 and spent \$51,446 as of the 20-day postelection report on Public Question #2 (An Amendment to

the Stormwater Management and Combined Sewer Overflow Abatement Bond Act of 1989) and Public Question #3 (An Amendment and Supplement to the Water Supply Bond Act of 1981).

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*This press release is a compilation of figures reported to the Commission on the 20-day postelection reports, due on November 24, 1997. Only those reports filed as of December 2nd are a part of this release.*

*The figures contained in this release are subject to change after the reports are more fully reviewed. Although the Commission has taken all reasonable precautions to prevent any mathematical or typographical errors, the possibility that some may exist cannot be entirely eliminated. Copies of any report on file with the Commission are available for inspection during regular office hours. It should be noted that the Commission has the ability to arrange the data in various formats upon request.*

*Also, please be reminded that certain candidates may maintain a total of two committees per election: a single candidate committee and a joint candidates committee. The figures representing fundraising and spending by a particular candidate may, therefore, reflect the fundraising and spending of the candidate's single candidate committee plus a pro-rata share of the candidate's joint candidates committee. For example, if a candidate has a joint candidates committee consisting of two candidates, one-half of the fundraising and spending by the joint candidates committee will be added to the candidate's single candidate committee figures.*

*The term "receipts," as used in this press release, means fundraising for the 1997 general election, as well as funds carried over from the primary election (and other past elections, if applicable). Therefore, receipts figures represent all funds available to the candidate as of the 20-day postelection report.*

*Finally, candidates and committees may transfer funds among each other. Although these transfers are compiled in the Commission's statistics, they are not transactions which necessarily create new funds. Nevertheless, the Commission's preliminary figures create a useful indicator of overall fundraising and spending in the 1997 general election.*
