## PRESS ADVISORY

Executive Director Jeffrey M. Brindle announced today that the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission is proposing readoption with amendments of N.J.A.C. 19:25, and proposed new rule, N.J.A.C. 19:25-26.10.

The proposed new rule, N.J.A.C. 19:25-26.10, Recordkeeping; Period of Retention for Business Entities, provides that a business entity that is required to file an annual disclosure statement must make or obtain and maintain records that the disclosure statement is based upon, and retain such records for a period of not less than four years after the date the annual report was filed, or a period of not less than four years after the due date for the annual report, whichever is longer.

The proposal was published in the New Jersey Register on December 21, 2009, and is available on the Commission's website at [www.elec.state.nj.us](http://www.elec.state.nj.us). Copies of the Commission's proposal may also be obtained by calling the Commission at (609) 292-8700.
