
PRESS ADVISORY

One mayoral and twelve municipal candidates must pay fines and fees totaling \$4,711.60 for violating the Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Reporting Act, the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) announced today.

These enforcement actions, known as final decisions, were approved by the Commission at its October 20, 2020 meeting. In addition, ELEC on October 28, 2020 issued 47 complaints against candidates for the 2018 general election for failure to file reports or late reporting. They, too, could face substantial fines.
