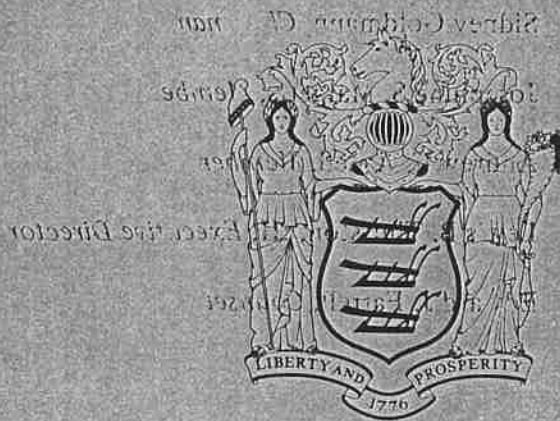

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INTRODUCTION

This report concerns contributions and expenditures in the 1979 Assembly General Election and the involvement of Political Action Committees in that election. Information on campaign spending was obtained from disclosure reports filed by the candidates and campaign committees over four reporting periods. Information on contributions by Political Action Committees was obtained from reports filed by the PACs.

The primary researcher for this report was Thaddeus S. Paszek, II.

Assembly candidates in the 1979 General Election raised more than \$3.1 million and spent more than \$2.8 million on their campaigns. Spending in last year's Assembly races was about \$850,000 more than in 1977.

A total of 200 candidates ran for Assembly seats in the 1979 General Election, with 163 candidates reporting to the Election Law Enforcement Commission that they spent more than \$1,000 on their campaigns. Those 163 candidates reported raising a total of \$3,119,145 and spending \$2,814,187. (See Tables A-I and A-II.)

In 1977, 158 Assembly candidates reported that they spent more than \$1,000. Their total spending was \$1,960,793. In 1975, 157 Assembly candidates reported spending more than \$1,000. Spending by those candidates totaled \$1,477,865.

All 80 seats in the Assembly were up for election in 1979. In 1977, elections were held for both the Assembly and 40-member State Senate. (Senate spending in 1977 totaled \$1,711,077.) There also were special Senate elections last year in the 22nd and 28th Legislative Districts. (See Table A-VI.)

Democrats kept control of the Assembly last November, winning 44 seats to 36 for the Republicans. In the 1978-79 legislative session, Democrats outnumbered Republicans in the Assembly by 54-to-26.

Eighty Democrats, 75 Republicans and eight independents reported spending more than \$1,000 on the 1979 Assembly campaigns. Those Democratic candidates raised a total of \$1,695,414 and spent \$1,505,566. The Republicans raised \$1,396,982 and spent \$1,283,710. The independents raised \$26,749 and spent \$24,911.

The average spending by the 80 Democratic candidates was \$18,820, while the 75 Republicans averaged \$17,116. Spending by the eight independent candidates averaged \$3,114.

Winning candidates spent \$1,701,447 on their campaigns, for an average of \$21,268. Spending by losing candidates totaled \$1,112,740, for an average of \$9,273.

In 1977, Republican Assembly candidates spent \$1,033,152, while Democrats spent \$916,719. Independents spent \$10,922. Average spending by the Republicans was \$13,193, while Democratic candidates averaged \$11,459. Average spending by winning candidates was \$13,713, while losing candidates averaged \$6,748.

There were 14 Assembly Districts last year in which total spending by all candidates exceeded \$75,000. (See Table A-II) They were District 1 (\$107,823), 2 (\$169,293), 3 (\$101,860), 6 (\$110,089), 7 (\$106,527), 8 (\$116,408), 9 (\$161,493), 10 (\$124,536), 14 (\$116,446), 22 (\$76,463), 25 (\$95,104), 27 (\$108,815) 38 (\$83,322) and 40 (\$90,783).

In 1977, total spending exceeded \$75,000 in four Assembly Districts. They were Districts 16 (\$75,308), 20 (\$75,590), 30 (\$97,115) and 39 (\$96,573).

There were 26 Assembly candidates in 1979 who spent more than \$30,000 on their campaigns. (See Table A-IV.) Spending by the 26 candidates ranged from \$30,771 to \$50,999. Fourteen of the candidates were Republicans and 12 were Democrats. Eighteen of the 26 won their elections.

Of the more than \$3.1 million raised for Legislative races, approximately 86 percent of the money came in contributions exceeding \$100. Candidates received from individuals, labor groups and business 38 contributions or loans of \$1,000 or more. Those contributions and loans totaled \$66,948, or about 2 percent of the money raised.

One of the more significant sources of campaign funds in the 1979 General Election were Political Action Committees (PACs). About 14 percent of the money contributed to the 1979 legislative races came from 30 PACs with total contributions of more than \$1,000. (See Table A-VII.) Those 30 PACs provided candidates and committees with a total of \$490,489.

Ten PACs made total contributions of \$15,000 or more. They were: New Jersey Organization for a Better State (New Jobs), \$59,800; Realtors PAC (REPAC), \$57,050; New Jersey Dental Association, \$54,125; Lawyers Encouraging Government & Law (LEGAL), \$45,375; New Jersey Independent Insurance Agents (NJIIA), \$36,700; New Jersey Automobile Dealers Association (NJ-CAR), \$34,150; New Jersey Food Council, \$26,520; New Jersey Education Association (NJEA-PAC), \$22,850; Jersey Bankers (JEBPAC), \$20,150, and Professional Insurance Agents (PIAPAC), \$15,850.

Of the 206 candidates for Assembly and Senate, 121 received at least one PAC contribution. (See candidate charts.) Five candidates received contributions from at least 20 PACs. They were Christopher Jackman, D-33 (23 PACs, \$9,178); Walter Kavanaugh, R-16 (23 PACs, \$7,588); Dean Gallo, R-24 (22 PACs, \$8,928); James Hurley, R-1 (22 PACs, \$8153); Donald DiFrancesco, R-22 (21 PACs, \$8,428), and A.J. Fortunato, D-27 (20 PACs, \$5,778). All incumbents running for reelection received at least one PAC contribution.

Forty-one candidates received more than \$5,000 from PACs. (See Table A-VIII.) The total contributed to the 41 candidates was \$269,062, or 59 percent of the money given by the 30 PACs. Thirty-eight of those 41 candidates were incumbent legislators. Only one of 41 was not elected. Twenty-seven of the candidates were Republicans, while 14 were Democrats.

PACs also contributed early in the legislative campaigns. According to PAC reports filed with the Election Law Enforcement Commission, \$398,564 had been contributed as of 25 days before the election; \$49,190 as of seven days before the election; \$41,177 as of 15 days after the election, and \$25,058 as of 60 days after the election.
